Bulletin Circular 1 – COVID-19 Communique

DATE: 26 MARCH 2020

SUBJECT: LOCKDOWN REGULATIONS AND IMPORTANT NUMBERS

As we are all aware that the President of the Republic, His Excellency Cyril Ramaphosa, on Monday the 23rd March 2020, addressed the nation to make an important announcement in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic currently facing our country. In his address to the nation, the President made an important announcement that the entire country of South Africa, will as from the 26th March 2020 at 24h00 midnight be under total lockdown until the 16th April 2020 at 24h00 midnight as part of the measures to curb the spread of the COVID-19 (Corona virus) in our country.

Subsequent to the President's announcement, National Government has proclaimed a set of Regulations to regulate the conduct expected from all South Africans during this lockdown period. The Regulations were published in the Gazette No. 11063 Volume 657 of the 25 March 2020. The Regulations are herewith attached for your information.
