

REPORT OF THE FINANCE PORTFOLIO COMMITTEE ON THE DIVISION OF REVENUE AMENDMENT BILL [B09-2020]

The Finance Portfolio Committee received the Division of Revenue amendment Bill on 2nd July 2020. The Committee was briefed by National Treasury officials on Thursday 16th of July 2020.

In accordance with section 118 (1)(a) of the Constitution, the committee must facilitate public involvement in the legislative process. Accordingly, the Bill was placed on the Legislature's website together with a notice calling for written submissions. Furthermore, advertisements were published in print media in KwaZulu-Natal calling for written submissions on the Bill. However, no written submissions were received.

The NCOP dates for the negotiating and final mandates are the 17th and 21st of July 2020, respectively. On 17th July 2020, the NCOP Select Committee on Appropriations met to consider the provincial negotiating mandates. No amendments to the Bill emanated from that meeting.

The Finance Portfolio Committee met on 16th July 2020 to consider the negotiating mandate. The committee agreed to confer a negotiating mandate to the NCOP and recommended that the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature; -

1. Adopts the report of the Finance Portfolio Committee in respect of the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B09- 2020]
2. Confers authority on the head of the provincial delegation to the NCOP or a delegate designated by the head of the delegation, to cast a vote in favour of the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B09-2020] at the NCOP plenary.
