**Tuesday, 12 July 2022**

The Virtual House met at 08h32.

1. 08h33 Members were given an opportunity for silent prayers or meditation.
2. 08h34 The Speaker made announcements, including the passing away of the following persons:
  - 2.1 King Zanozuko Tyelovuyo Sigcau, of the Royal House of the amaMpondo Kingdom;
  - 2.2 Twenty-two teenagers who lost their lives at a tavern in Scenery Park, East London;
  - 2.3 Two people who were shot and killed in a tavern shooting in Katlehong last Friday night;
  - 2.4 Fifteen people who were shot and killed in a Tavern in Orlando East Soweto; and

2.5 Four people who were shot and killed in a tavern in Sweetwaters, Pietermaritzburg.

*The Virtual House observed a minute of silence.*

4. 08h42 Mr BM Zuma moved the following formal motion:

This motion is a Motion without Notice, moved under Standing Rule 105(1)(g) with the unanimous concurrence of all the Members present in the House.

The Presiding Officer is requested to put the motion to the vote for approval as a Resolution of the House under Standing Rule 103(2).

**Noting that:**

[1] The President has by proclamation determined the total remuneration packages of public office bearers, in terms of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998).

[2] In terms of proclamation No. 67 of 2022, the upper limit of the salary and allowances of the Premier has been thus determined.

[3] The Legislature is required, in terms of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 and having regard to the provisions of Proclamation No. 67 of 2022, to determine by resolution the upper limits of the Premier's salary and allowances, the amount of the pension contribution to the pension fund of which the Premier is a member, as well as the amount of the medical aid contribution.

**This House therefore resolves:**

[1] That the total remuneration package of the Premier, subject to the provisions of the Act and Proclamation 67 of 2022, shall be as follows:

LA	1	Premier	R2.328.221

[2] That the total remuneration package shall include all the elements set out in the proclamation.
