# **MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS**

**Tuesday, 15 November 2022**

The Hybrid House met at 08h00.

1. 08h01 Members were given an opportunity for silent prayers or meditation.
2. 08h31 The Speaker made announcements, including the passing away of the following persons:
  - 2.1 Mr Sbonelo Justice Luthuli, Branch Chairperson in Ward 12, uMshwathi Subregion;
  - 2.2 Ms Mbali Banda, a staff member in the office of the MEC for Sport, Arts and Culture, as well as Regional Secretary of the SA Youth Council (SAYC) in uMkhanyakude; and
  - 2.3 Mr Phumulani Emmanuela Gabuza, Councillor of Ward 2, uMsunduzi Municipality.

*The Hybrid House observed a minute of silence.*

3. 08h05 The Speaker read into the record the tabling of the Report of the Portfolio Committee on Social Development on the Children's Amendment Bill [B18D-2020].
4. 08h06 Debate and Conferral of a Final and Voting Mandate on the Children's Amendment Bill [B18D – 2020] commenced and was concluded at 08h47.

*Question put:*

That the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature agrees to confer a final mandate on the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Delegation to the National Council of Provinces to vote in support of the Children's Amendment Bill [B18D – 2020] at the relevant NCOP select committee; and

That the head of the provincial delegation to the NCOP, or a delegate designated by the head of the delegation, cast a vote in favour of the Children's Amendment Bill [B18D – 2020] at the NCOP plenary.

*Agreed to.*

Abstentions = 0
