## **MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS**

The Virtual House met at 08h30.

  - 2.1 Mr Harry Belafonte, singer, actor and civil rights activist who worked closely with South African artists, including Miriam Makeba, to ensure South Africa's struggle against apartheid remained in the international spotlight and on the international agenda;

- 2.2 Mr Chris "Che" Matlhako, SACP Central Committee Member and General Secretary of the Friends of Cuba Society: South Africa, who contributed to the struggle for social justice and the emancipation of all those at the bottom of the economic pyramid;
- 2.3 All victims of gender-based violence, femicide and hate crime;
- **2.4** All public servants and traditional leaders of this province and the country at large; and
- **2.5** All victims of road fatalities in our province during the recent past.
