8.2 Debate on the following 1st DA Party Motion:

On Thursday, 29 June 2023, hon LM Meyer of the DA moved as follows:

This House notes:

The total collapse of eThekwini and uMsunduzi which are either under administration or facing administration; and

That most ANC municipalities in KwaZulu-Natal are financially dysfunctional and unable to deliver basic services.

This House therefore resolves:

To look to uMngeni Municipality and the great strides it has made as an example of what can be done in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal under a new DA government.

8.3 Debate on the following 1st EFF Party Motion:

On Thursday, 22 September 2022, hon N Dlamini of the EFF moved as follows:

This House notes:

The violent riots in KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng during July 2021 when 36 black people were killed by racist Indians in Phoenix;

The massacre of black people in Phoenix was motivated by racism and hatred of Africans; and

A year after the Phoenix massacre, there has been no justice for the victims.

This House therefore resolves:

To establish an ad hoc committee to investigate the causes of the Phoenix massacre;

To receive submissions from the public on the impact and aftermath of the massacre on the affected communities; and

To establish a special fund for victims of the Phoenix massacre.
