  - 8.1 Debate on the following 2<sup>nd</sup> ANC Party Motion:

**On Thursday, 25 May 2023, hon Mr SA Duma of the ANC moved as follows:**

**Le Ndlu:**

Iyalitusa futhi iyalazisa iqhaza elabanjwa yiSilo

***This House:***

*Praises and acknowledges the role played by the late  
Amazulu King Zwelithini, for being the biggest champion  
of development and peacemaking.*

*Notes that the King was indeed true to his words and  
stood by the truth.*

***This House therefore resolves:***

*That King Goodwill kaBhekuzulu be honoured with a  
stand-alone statue in the Legislature precincts; and*

*That this statue, once erected, must stand taller than all  
other existing statues to demonstrate our late King's  
heroism.*

8.2 Debate on the following 2<sup>nd</sup> IFP Party Motion:

On Thursday, 24 November 2022, hon Mr MB Gwala of the IFP moved as follows:

**This House notes:**

With concern the allegations of pension fraud taking place in government departments around the country – the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature included;

That members of the GEPF are being swindled out of their hard-earned pensions without their knowledge; and

That while government, the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature and unions are always quick to condemn corruption, they have been shockingly silent on this matter involving the GEPF.

**This House therefore resolves:**

To call upon the Premier of KwaZulu-Natal to appoint a commission of inquiry into the alleged corruption at the GEPF or, failing which, for the IFP to intervene in this matter.
