2.1 Mr Jini Patrick Khoza, husband to honourable Ms NM Khoza, MEC for Social Development. Mr Khoza was the Mayor of Sisonke District, which is now called Harry Gwala

District Municipality, from December 2000 until March 2011;

- 2.2 Mr Bonginkosi Ntuli, a South African professional soccer player who started his career with Golden Arrows back in 2012 and, while he was on the books of Mamelodi Sundowns between 2014 and 2019, he spent much of that time on loan at other clubs and had been playing for AmaZulu Football Club as a striker;
- 2.3 Mr Marc Rantseli, a singer-songwriter and member of the legendary duo *MarcAlex*. Marc Alex gained popularity in the 1980s with their hit song "Quick Quick" which reached number 1 on the South African music charts. Marc also spent a few years working at the Southern African Music Rights Organisation (SAMRO), advocating for the rights of musicians in this country;
- 2.4 Mr Xolile Irvin "DJ Amen" Sihlophe, Ukhozi FM sports presenter. Mr Sihlophe worked in almost all departments at Ukhozi FM, including religious shows, sports and education. He worked for Ukhozi for more than 15 years, presenting a religious show called Unkulunkulu Nomuntu Omusha. He presented and produced many sports shows, among others. Mr Sihlophe was also an events director, known for organising the popular Uvukile Gospel Festival, together with his friend and business partner Pastor Mjosty;
- 2.5 Mr Vela Henry Shandu, headman (Induna) of the Mathonsi Traditional Council in Mandeni who was shot dead by an unknown gunman who came to his home, pretending to want to discuss land matters;
- 2.6 All victims of gender-based violence, femicide and hate crime;
- 2.7 All public servants and traditional leaders in KwaZulu-Natal and the country at large; and

2.8 All victims of road fatalities in our province during the recent past.
