3. O8h36 Debate and Voting on the Conferral of a Final Mandate on the Economic Regulation of Transport Bill [B1D-2020] commenced and was concluded at O9h24.

Question put:

That the KZN provincial delegation to the NCOP cast a vote in support of the Economic Regulation of Transport Bill [B1D-2020] at the relevant NCOP select committee, and

That the head of the provincial delegation to the NCOP, or a delegate designated by the head of the delegation, cast a vote in support of the Economic Regulation of Transport Bill [B1D-2020] at the NCOP plenary.

Question agreed to.
