 - 2.2 Mr Siphiwe Mkhonza, former Kaizer Chiefs and Bloemfontein Celtic defender and popular TV analyst. Mr Mkhonza began his career at the now

defunct Celtic Football Club in 1999 and turned out for Ria Stars and Lamontville Golden Arrows before joining Chiefs in 2004. After leaving Amakhosi in 2007, Mkhonza played for SuperSport United, Maritzburg United, AmaZulu and Black Leopards. He was an analyst on SABC for a number of years after his playing career;
