Resolution re Adoption of the Standing Rules of the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature:

This House notes:

- That, in accordance with section 116(1)(a) and (b) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, a provincial legislature may –
 - (a) determine and control its internal arrangements, proceedings and procedures; and
 - (b) make Rules and Orders concerning its business;
- 2. That the Sixth Legislature of KwaZulu-Natal adopted new Standing Rules to govern its internal arrangements, proceedings, procedures and business, and further amended those Standing Rules, and
- 3. That the Standing Rules remained in operation until the expiry of the term of the Sixth Legislature.

This House therefore resolves:

To adopt the Standing Rules, as adopted and amended by the Sixth Legislature of KwaZulu-Natal.
