MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

Tuesday, 30 April 2024

The Virtual House met at 08h30.

- 1. 08h31 Members were given an opportunity for silent prayers or meditation.
- 2. 08h32 The Speaker made announcements, including the passing away of the following persons:
 - 2.1 Inkosi BN Mdletshe, former Speaker of the KwaZulu-Natal Legislature. Inkosi Mdletshe was part of the institution between 1994 and 2013. A lawyer by training and a traditional leader in uMkhanyakude District, Inkosi Mdletshe served the Legislature in various capacities. He was a member of several portfolio committees such as Health,

Conservation, the Premier and Royal Household, *inter alia.* Inkosi Mdletshe was the Speaker between 1998 and 2004 and retired from the Legislature midway through the Fourth Administration;

- 2.2 Mr Sikhumbuzo Gumede, Deputy Director General at the Department of Co-operative Governance and Traditional Affairs;
- 2.3 Mr Dingaan "The Rose of Soweto" Thobela, a three-time world boxing champion. Mr Dingaan Thobela held three world titles in two weight divisions, the WBO and WBA lightweight titles, as well as the WBC Super Middleweight title which he won in 2000;
- 2.4 All victims of gender-based violence, femicide and hate crimes;
- 2.5 All public servants and traditional leaders of this province and the country at large; and
- 2.6 All victims of road fatalities in our province during the recent past.
