KWAZULU-NATAL LEGISLATURE TO HOST A HIGH-POWERED DELEGATION FROM ESWATINI PARLIAMENT THIS WEEK

The KwaZulu-Natal Legislature, under the leadership of Speaker Honourable Nontembeko Boyce, will be hosting eSwatini Parliament on a two-day visit. The two institutions will share parliamentary best practices under the auspices of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association (CPA) that they are both members of.

The high-level delegation will comprise members of the Senate, the Deputy Speaker as well as members of Parliament and it will be in the province from the 4th of September to the 5th of September 2025.

The session is part of the resolutions adopted during CPA's last session held in New South Wales, Australia last year under the theme 'Engage, empower, sustain: charting the course for resilient democracy'. The engagements between KwaZulu-Natal Legislature and eSwatini Parliament are therefore designed to serve as a platform for sharing best practices in legislative governance and operations.
